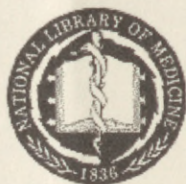

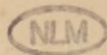

Herewith we hand you our revised Price Current, corrected to date.



Our friends will note a gratifying decline in prices since our last, and they may be assured that we shall be prompt to give them the benefit of any future decline.

A few articles are in small stock — prominent among these are Cantharides, Cardamoms, Vanilla Beans, and Oil of Bay. Of the latter article Government has seized all to be found. The duty on this oil is \$17.50 (gold) per pound, while it has been selling for less than that figure in currency. Rhubarb Root is in good supply, at lower figures, and of improved quality.

We purpose to continue to give our attention mainly to the jobbing trade. Our entire stock is laid in with a view to the wants of the critical retailer. We have no outlet for poor goods, and consequently avoid them.

The quotations annexed, it will be understood, are for broken packages, in moderate quantities. More favorable figures may often be given for considerable quantities, and certainly will be for full packages.

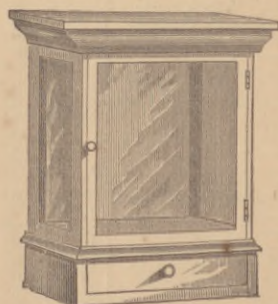

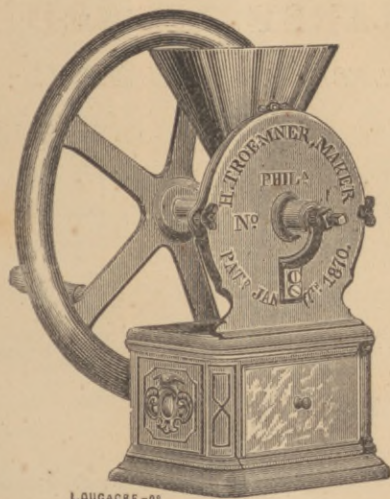

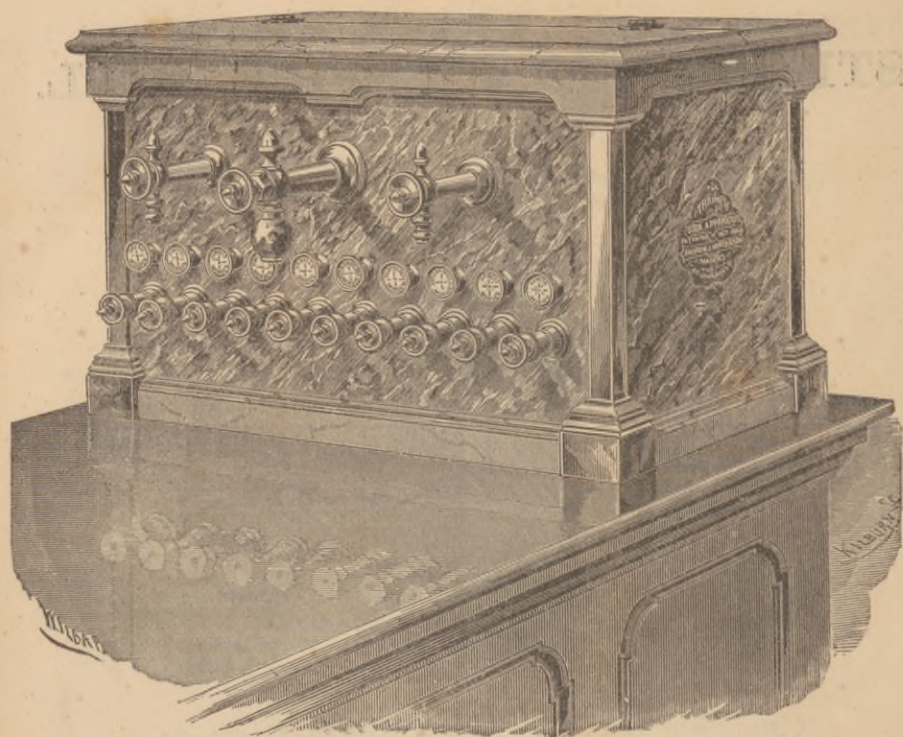
