REPORT.

The Committee appointed by the New York County Medical Society, to make a correct list of its members, respectfully present the following report. They have placed the names in alphabetical order. And under appropriate headings is placed such information as was thought of interest to the profession.

Since the organization of the Society, in the year 1806, to the present time, 1861, there have been admitted, according to the records of the Society, 826 members, whose names will be found below, 378 of whom are ascertained to be dead.

On referring to the causes of death it will be found that in 130 ascertained cases, one-fifth was caused by consumption, one-ninth by apoplexy, and one-fourteenth by softening of the brain. If these three causes are added together, it will be found they constitute a fraction more than one-half the entire number of deaths.
