

REGIMENTAL SURGEONS OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, IN THE WAR OF THE REBELLION, 1861-3. only

At a meeting of this society in 1862, I presented a list of the surgeons from the State of New York who were engaged in the military service of the United States.

Dr. O. White, delegate from the New York Academy of Medicine, presented the following resolution, which was unanimously adopted:

Resolved, That the thanks of the State Medical Society be accorded to its Secretary, Dr. S. D. Willard, for the laborious compilation he has made of the medical men who have entered the army from the State of New York, and that he be requested to continue the same.

In compliance with this testimony of the Society's approbation of my labor, and in execution of my original design, to procure the names, and, so far as possible, a notice of the labors of those of our profession who have been engaged in the military service, I again present the list of regimental surgeons, revised, and with additions to the present date. What at first seemed no very difficult task, has grown, with the unexpected magnitude of the war, into what now appears an enterprise almost impossible to accomplish. The list of the surgeons which our State has furnished in the various departments of the service must therefore go forth incomplete, and for the present the history of their labors unwritten. One reason for this may be attributed to the fact that, in the progress of the startling events which have been developed in the last two years of our national history, almost every member of the profession. prompted by patriotism and professional pride, has been eager to render some service for the country, and there are but few surgeons of prominence who have not been called upon in one way or another to contribute accordingly.

To present the names of the medical and surgical force of New York complete, would be to embrace, 1st. All those who have entered the regular army. 2d. Those who have entered the navy. 3d. Those who have received appointments of surgeons of United

States volunteers, and placed in charge of brigades, divisions, general hospitals, or as medical inspectors. This number has been largely increased from last year. 4th. A considerable number of militia regiments were called into temporary service, which in many instances were not accompanied by their regular surgeons, and the names of the substitutes do not appear on the muster rolls, at the office of the Adjutant General; and more recently the militia force has been again ordered into the field to repel the invasion into Pennsylvania, and while their surgeons are doing good service, their names cannot at present be obtained.

5th. The Sanitary Commission have likewise had a large and able corps of surgeons in their employ, laboring in the hospitals and on the scores of transports, visiting every battle field, and rendering, so far as they could, most acceptable service in every department. The Commission have also employed some of the most distinguished members of the profession, in the several loyal States, many of whom were from New York, to visit and inspect the various military hospitals of the government, and to report upon their general

and sanitary condition.

6th. Quite a large number of the younger members of the profession have been acting as assistant surgeons at some of the general military hospitals about Washington, Alexandria, Baltimore and New York, without rank of office, and under direct contract with the Surgeon General's Department at Washington. There have been surgeons appointed also to the various military posts in the State. To complete a list of this large number, at a time when mighty events are culminating and absorbing the interest of almost every pursuit, would be almost impossible, even with leisure for its accomplishment. It would comport with my wishes to posses the material for a suitable biographical dictionary of the medical corps of the State of New York, who have been engaged in this war; and which should embrace a full account of their various camp, field and general hospital service, together with a synopsis of their operations and experience. I am aware of the amount of labor the preparation of such a volume would involve. and of the length of time that would be required for its completion. Of course it could not be commenced until peace shall be restored, but the material should be gathered; and I should feel myself under great obligations to every surgeon who would embody all that relates to himself and send me for such a purpose. I could gather the material for some one who might hereafter use it. would be only a deserved tribute to those who have so faithfully performed their many difficult duties in this bloody war.

Much has been said within the past year of the inefficiency of the medical Department, and of the incompetency of some of the surgeons, but the State of New York is chargeable with only a moderate part of this inefficiency. Many of the surgeons are learned and accomplished men. The great demand for assistant surgeons has necessitated the appointment of many young men, who have but recently left the schools. This could not be otherwise when the pay is so inadequate to the service to be performed, and so entirely insufficient to meet the expenses of men more advanced in professional life.

These had no fixed prejudices to overcome, and have, perhaps, the more easily learned the great principles of modern surgery. That there have been individual exceptions to the competency of some of the medical staff is not to be denied, nor should it have been expected to be otherwise; but, as a body, the medical corps reflect credit upon the profession and upon the State, and have been diligent and faithful officers. More than four hundred names have been added to the list of regimental surgeons and assistant surgeons within the last twelve months, most of whom have received appointments.

Those connected with the first forty regiments which were enlisted for two years, from May, 1861, have been mustered out, their term of service having expired. A few have been dismissed the service, while a large number of resignations have occurred. There are some whom death has overtaken. They were found in their armor, ministering to the wants of their fellow soldiers, or exhausted from the labors they had already performed. Their names will be held in grateful remembrance; and their self sacrificing devotion to their profession, and the cause of their country, will rest as an unfading laurel upon their graves.

My thanks are due to Surgeon General Quackenbush for the ready access that has been afforded in his Department, and to his assistant, Mr. Willis Merriman, who has again facilitated my labor.
