## DIRECTIONS FOR USING

The ordinary dose for an adult is two teaspoonfuls, given in hot water with sugar and milk, if preferred. Children should be given less, according to age, with plenty of milk; or, if for colic, lime water, sweetened or not, may be added to the dose, to cover its pungency. Dose can be repeated if patient is not relieved.

Children are usually easily affected by small doses, while some individuals require a larger dose than others—some may be happily relieved by a very small dose.

The remedy is somewhat pungent and unpleasant to take except when required for a greater discomfort or pain.

Adults affected with these ailments usually require moderately full doses of the "Compound Extract of Smart-Weed." It is well borne and relieves the pain and distress.

The diet and drinks advised for children should be used and no food taken.

Clearing out the lower bowel by injection of quite warm water with a little salt, used freely, is a great comfort and aid.

Water, sterilized by boiling, should be given in moderate quantities to relieve thirst.

The bowel may be flushed with warm water as follows:—Take a small teaspoonful of salt to a pint of boiled water that has been allowed to cool until a little more than lukewarm and inject this with a fountain syringe.

Milk often causes the attacks, and this may be replaced by the juice squeezed from rare broiled beef or mutton, which is equally nourishing and does not ferment.

In some hospitals for children food is withheld for two days and plenty of boiled water is given.

If cow's milk has to be given later, as recovery takes place, it must be diluted with boiled water, or thin oatmeal water and a little cream and milk-sugar added.

The milk of common cows or of Holstein, Durham and Devon cows is better than that of Jersey or of Guernsey cows.
