
Dear Rosalind,

Many thanks for sending me a copy of your paper, which I read with great interest. I have pencilled one or two suggested amendments and those on page 5 and 7-8 I think you should treat seriously whatever you do about the others.

We have some purified potato virus X at the moment, and would give you some if you could make use of it almost immediately.
