I have a new liquid fatty acid isolated from the wax of tubercle bacilli. The acid is similar to, possibly homologous with, the liquid fatty acid obtained from the phosphatide. I could bring you a sample of the substance by Wednesday next week if that would be convenient for you. At the same time I shall also bring a sample of palmitic acid.
