Dear Mr. Lederberg:

It is a happy occasion for me when I can send to a candidate for a fellowship the final word that the fellowship has been awarded. I therefore take pleasure in sending to you a copy of the letter to Professor Sinnott notifying him of the action of our Board of Managers in appointing you a Fellow of The Jane Coffin Childs Memorial Fund for Medical Research and in making a grant for the fellowship. I hope you will read the letter of notification carefully and let me know whether the conditions of the fellowship are acceptable to you.

If any publication results from the work which you will be doing during the period of the fellowship, it should carry an acknowledgment to the Fund as indicated in the letter of notification. If you will advise me at the time when the manuscript is accepted for publication, I can arrange to have 125 copies purchased, of which 25 copies are to be sent to this Fund for binding in our Collected Papers.

We hope that the period of your stay in New Haven will be profitable. It will be a privilege to see if we may be of any assistance in accomplishing that desire. You will recall that we discussed the opportunities available of visiting a number of laboratories at Yale in which problems of normal and abnormal growth are being investigated. There will be, I hope, some meetings of the Atypical Growth Research Unit after you have come to New Haven. I will be glad to have you visit me in this office and will be pleased to assist in making arrangements for you to visit such laboratories as you may wish.
