No obvious faults, nor easy answers to the questions you raise. Wait to see confirmations! (But I don't think we'll jump into it here).

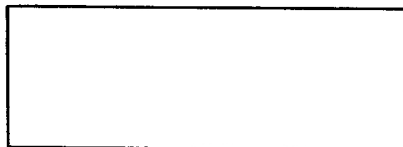
It would be very wonderful to revisit Australia after 14 years; but the occasional opportunities simply have not coincided with my own possibilities. However, I do not abandon hope.
