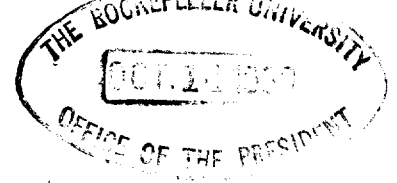

It finally dawned on me that the number given in your strain list for the "parent" of the parent of W4183 must be a Cavalli number and not a Wisconsin number. I wrote to Cavalli, he kindly wrote to Italy, someone kindly sent copies of the appropriate pages of his strain notebooks, and the pedigree for W4183 is now complete (enclosed).

In the meantime Somerville checked out the strain and mapped the arg marker. It is arg G and the strain behaves as it should.
