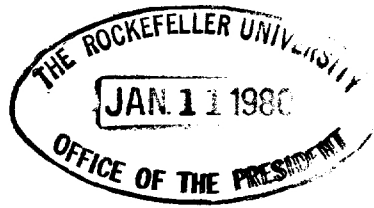

Josh:

There have been economic, black fly  
& parasite infestation measurements to  
assess the project to date. They  
indicate little resettlement of the lands  
in the heavily infested areas because  
of other factors. Black fly (infested) pop<sup>n</sup>  
is effectively reduced by spraying but  
new infestation from areas beyond the  
control region introduce reinfestation  
over distances previously thought  
impossible. It seems to be a  
"disease suppression" program - not  
eradication. It is expensive and  
only affects one of many health problems  
in the countries. There is no end in  
sight! It is still considered the best game  
in town. When
