Dear Jack:

On Friday March 7, I have only 30 minutes and I had planned to discuss with you the matter of honoring KL who received the Nobel Award fifty years ago, Dec 10, 1930. I was associated with him from 1925-1932 and I have been collecting and classifying items relative to him as a scientist and as a person.

Chase I have been thinking in terms of an exhibit showing his test tubes, racks, filter etc used 50 years ago. He will discuss details with Longa.

Additionally we are thinking also about an AM or PM meeting with brief addresses by Michael Heidelberger, Walter Good, Chase and myself. I was near satisfied with the failure to name KL as a Nobel laureate with his numerous contributions during the 1976 celebration of the Rockefeller Inst. & University when Flexner was honored as the first director of the R.I. For years I have thought about honoring KL and we now have an indication for - 50 years after receiving the Nobel Award.
