Dear Dr. Lederberg:

I have enclosed a copy of the draft final report submitted to NSF in accordance with our contract for the project entitled, "The Implications of Potential Resource and Environmental Constraints for Economic Growth." As you know, I am circulating copies of this report to all members of the Advisory Committee and to the review committee which we established at the February conference. The contract provides only for a 30 day review period. With a report of this size we recognize that it is impossible for you to consider all of it.

The material in Chapter I is a summary of the full report. Chapters II and III provide background material for those readers who were not initially involved so they can be informed of the sequence of events that were undertaken to perform the work. Chapter IV is our attempt to extract from our meetings throughout the project, the commissioned papers, and discussion at the final conference an integrated discussion of the research issues. It is this chapter which we feel would be most benefited throm your reactions.

Both John and I have appreciated your involvement in the project over the past year and a half and recognize that your time may be especially limited at this time of the year. Thus, if it is not possible for you to provide your reaction to this chapter within the one month that NSF allows we will understand.
