

Dear Josh:

I want to thank you for your letter of June 11, and for your thoughtful and helpful comments about the current vacancy for the Medical College Deanship. The concerns that you express so well regarding the organizational and functional problems have been very much in the minds of the Search Committee. The search is now moving along well, and we hope to avoid an interregnum.
