

Dear Sir:

The problem of your completion of the New York State Education Department's English requirement of six points has been given careful consideration. I have consulted with the Pre-Medical Office and with Mr. Edward J. Grant, the Registrar. It has been decided that you should take the initiative of appealing to Dr. Horace L. Field, Chief of the Bureau of Qualifying Certificates and Professional Examinations, State Education Department, Albany, New York, for special consideration by the Department. In other words, you should request Dr. Field as soon as possible to consider your requirement on the basis of the completion of the work you have had. The State Education Department will be sent immediately the medical qualifying certificate with the statement that you have been instructed to make this petition. We will also attach a transcript of your record to Dr. Field.

I will notify Professor Fred S. Keller, the Chief Pre-Medical Adviser, and send him a copy of this letter. I would suggest if you have any difficulties that you communicate with him.
