Condorcet - Colonial States. War: new states. civil war or war of lib.
Then: centralization, assimilating to central culture, even if
polyethnic. Ethnocide. ... language, schools.
poetry as well as pedagogics.

Bettati - "Int'l law prohibits intervention" - UN charter
[human rights obligate it].
(legitimacy of the state)

Ribstein - Psychiatrist consent abrogated only for state
adherence. Need for meaning. addition \wedge equality. Justice; psychology
child learned by rules. "nicelike". Universal law.
curses of generations - loss of reference groups.
analogy of veterans

1. Third world - asking a German history... Dictatorships vs. interventions
European tradition - right of resistance 16th C. reforms. Rejection...
message of redemption. Temporal. To avoid continuing resistance
must be passive. Starters - magistrates, political parties. OK against
fascism. Then resistance is necessary.

Europe did not follow this history. Rights of revolution asserted; Colonization.
19th C. Interventions vs. revolution for Order: 20th C. Resistance to Hitler
Nazis needed mass killing. Pursuit of Order; Death of Peace; Execution as
dignity. More dangerous than revolution. Conservatism: Hitler could not fulfill
peace treaties, could not be limited. Only total annihilation... Christians
Modesten - forget solidarity of human rights.

- Bettati: • actors → intervenors (visitor)
• process (like ~~sootin~~)

^{legitimation < form < acceptance} Risk of alienation
Stone of action: political + legal constraints welfare state
need "blue cards" of assistance.

Riccoeur → Suffering of victim
Violence of assistance. - "Intervention is justified
