There is a great deal of merit in your suggestions concerning the compulsory use of seat belts in Wisconsin, despite the fact that, as you point out, it is one thing to get them in the car and another to accomplish their use.

Since any change of this nature must be made through legislative action, I suggest you discuss this matter with your State Senator and Assemblyman.
