Hirota has already made a very provocative discovery in the area of my immediate interest. It happens we have been unable to repeat his observation of the removal of the F factor by Cobalt, but as his colleagues have confirmed it, and he has sent us strains resulting from his treatment that are as they should be, there must be a subtle difference of experimental conditions.

Hirota is applying for admission in September. While this would be acceptable, I am writing to learn whether he could not as well begin next January, which would suit ot lab. situation a little better.
