We talked about following your unstable-lysogenicity-mutant in chains. I can see enough difficulties that it may be hard to do a clean experiment, but having it around if you care to send it, may help impel doing it.

I checked your terminal report on Flat transduction —x SW 543. It leasts 27 tests altogether, with FA; all give b's, 7 gave i's also. There were 71 control tests (not, spec. whether no FA, or heated FA), but only 7 gave any motiles, 4of them i, 3 b. In conversation, you implied you had gotten several dosen more spontaneous reversions— do you have more data, or did you mean you had done the 71 at tempts?
