May I acknowledge your letter of the 8th concenning the Lac3 mutants of Escherichia coli K-12.

Inasmuch as our studies on lactase adaptation in these mutants are still in progress, and no definitive description of them has been published, I would be reluctant to distribute them at the present time. I would not say that E. coli was very favorable material for adaptive enzyme studies (as compared, for example, with Pseudomonas fluorescens): it is quite difficult to study the kinetics of adaptation in non-growing cultures. It is only the groundwork of genetic analysis in this strain that would justify its ude for these studies.

Please let me know if I may be of assistance in any other way.
