Since TV was discontinued - Ads in magazines
have increased and samples are being
mailed to home where children can
interrupt the package -

I wish there was some way to enforce
the Cigarette Companies of paying into a
Special fund to provide needed funds
for the poverty & help less toward medical
attention instead of being a burden on welfare
and the tax payer.
