It is a pleasure to inform you that \$140,517 is awarded to Stanford University for twelve months support of the initial level of effort of the project entitled, "Molgen: A Computer Science Application to Molecular Genetics," as outlined in the above-numbered proposal. The project has been approved on scientific merit for approximately two years of effort. This project is under the direction of Edward A. Mølgenbaum, Department of Computer Science and Joshua Lederberg, Department of Genetics. This grant is effective June 1, 1973 and unless otherwise amended, will expire on November 30, 1973.

An unfunded period of six months is included in the award period to provide flexibility in the performance of the project.
