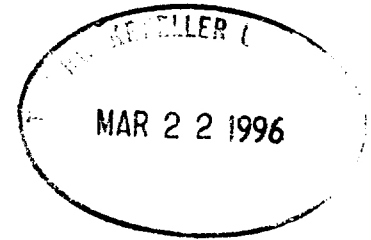

I enjoyed meeting you at the BENS Advisory Group meeting in New York on March 7. I also wanted to thank you for your suggestions and ideas about our push for ratification of the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC).

Things are moving ahead quite quickly on the CWC, and, as expected, Senator Helms and his staff are playing hardball. For your information, I have enclosed portions of a Senate Foreign Relations Committee staff report on the CWC.
