An International Symposium on the subject: "Enzymes: Units of Biological Structure and Function," will be held at Henry Ford Hospital, November 1, 2, 3, 1955. Advisory members of the Program Committee have selected you as a speaker who could make a real contribution to this event.

You will also receive an honorarium of \$125 in lieu of other expenses. Your participation is greatly desired, and we hope that you will find it possible to come.
