Per our conversation, enclosed are some pebbles on the human genome. I explicitly did not want to see a Manhattan Project come out of it.

As a footnote to that (and your remarks on Crick...) also my own affirmations of "sequence and central dogma", to which I devoted my Nobel lecture as a higher priority than receiving recombinants in bacteria.

As I think about your remarks:

- 1) Pauling + Campbell did real mischief to "specificity" theory generally with their spurious experiments on folding. ~ 1942
- 2) Renaturation and recovery of enzymatic activity was an important premonition of the sequence hypothesis. It is still miraculous that it works so well.

Do bring in Landsteiner.
