I have sent under separate cover the two strains we used in the stationary phase mutation studies. They are:

h-p histidine⁻ lactose⁺ This strain was obtained from Lampen in 1945 and was designated by him 148-334.

h-lac⁻ z^b Although to be certain I would have to check with the records which are now in Japan, I think that this is a single colony isolate of the mutant you sent in 1949.


