Under separate cover we are sending you cultures of our wild type W strain, and one diauxotroph and two triauxotrophs. The mutants have absolute requirements except for the PAB requirement which is slightly relative. The supplents we used in our tests for their growth requirement were in \(\cup /\mathrm{m}\)!:

L-tryptophan 20
L-histidine 40
DL-methionine 20
L-proline 40
DL-leucine 40
PABA 0.1

I'll be interested to hear how they behave in your tests for recombination.
