In response to your communication of October 29, 1951, we are sending you under separate cover the material which you request, as follows:

CDC phages - undiluted:

E₁, F₁, I, III - 1 ml ea

Cultures:

E₁, F₁

(mutants)
Phages E₁ and F₁ are adapted strains of Vi phage type II
Phages I and III are ~~unadapted~~ unadapted Vi phages which in combination lyse practically a Vi strain of *Staph.*
Phages E₁ and F₁ can be propagated on their natural homologous strains. Phage I should be propagated on culture F₁. Phage III should be cultivated on phage strain E₁.

Please advise us if these materials do not arrive within a reasonable time or if they do not arrive in usable condition.

We would appreciate also your notifying us if the materials do not react as they should.
