Bill Cherry and you might be interested that kunzendorf 302-50 is also susceptable (very few plaques) to PLT22, but I am not sure but what it does not react (on slides) with IV V XII serum to some extent, as well as with VI VII and VI VIII. So far, no transductions with it, and I haven't gotten the phage to grow well on it. Of the typing phages, BAOR transduces very nicely (e.g. to SM-666), but its host range is even more limited than PLT22.

I hope your trek West came out all right.
