I wonder whether you would drop me the number of the condenser you mentioned that could be used for both short and long working distances, and which also permits dark field illumination.

I want to take this opportunity to tell you that I really had a wonderful few hours in your laboratory and I have since enjoyed them in retrospect. I have repeated the protoplast clonal growth with the coli. I intend to make a serious attempt next week to get the megaterium to do the same thing.
