Dear Prof. Lederberg:

I'm afraid that the "Times" article did not convey the basic idea of the talk as adequately as I hoped it would.

The essential idea was that pollution is caused by a provincialism of thinking, bounded unrealistically by restricting the problem as you so well put, it in the 5/24/69 article in the Washington Post. The great mass of pollution is caused by incomplete use of materials as a result of basing values on extraction costs.

The objective of the talk, a copy of which is appended, is to stimulate the development of social economics, incorporating values other than that of extraction into the price of materials, so that complete and effective utilization of our resources is achieved.
