Subject Accomplishments of the Laboratory of Biochemical Genetics

> The major accomplishments of the Laboratory of Biochemical Genetics during the last ten years are as follows:

- 1. Demonstrated that treatment of neuroblastoma cells with cAMP results in increases in the abundance of some species of poly A+ RNA and the expression of voltagesensitive ion channel proteins and other neuronal proteins that are required for synaptogenesis.
- 2. Elucidated the mechanism by which cellular metabolites regulate the activity of <u>E</u>. coli adenylate cyclase.
- Demonstrated complex synergistic regulation of genes coding for enkephalin and 3. neuropeptide Y by cAMP, glucocorticoids, activators of protein kinase C, and nerve growth factor.
- Elucidated mechanisms involved in the formation, stabilization, and elimination of 4. nicotinic acetylcholine receptor aggregates during the development of neuromuscular synapses.
