In ancient times in the Orient an artist always used an assumed name to sign the pictures that he painted. The reason was that the artist then could never either be rewarded or punished by others for his work--the artist then would always be free--for no one, other than the artist, would know who to punish or who to reward. Now this is an interesting concept relevant to art and science today.

Certainly the concepts of freedom and creation for the sake of : deltode creation are moble ones But one of the magnificent aspects of science is responsible for the correctness of his works for ndividual related and hard to validate his work, to check it, to take pride wo in his findings or workmanship. For his colleagues judge his scientific ability on the basis of what he creates or what he tries to create. The basic values of the scientific community are simple and good. In essence, out pour it is a devotion to truth, and to integrity to one's craft.
