Told M. that I'd seen a librarian, EPE, + TF all leave the RF in a way that gave some basis for reflection as to the 1 gr appointment. He said he couldn't speak for Trustees but personally he thought that being already 10 yrs in service and I could look on appointment to RF as Director in MS as being the equivalent or the superior of academic post. I said that further than that I had nothing to add, and that I realized he, + Spoder and Day were in the same boat. He added that most of the men who had left the RF Boards landed extremely well.
