The first day back I received two patients to present to the Dean the next day. Today I learn I am #1 in my class and as such have quite a range of internship choices. I hope definitely to go into the specialty of internal medicine, and possibly the academic side of same — which means much satisfactory living, but a long period of starvation — one year's internship and about three or resident level, all at ridiculous salaries of something like \$100-150 a month — only board + room the 1st year.

I will have no difficulty remaining at Michigan you can see, and may choose to do so, the academic opportunities better here. It will apply also to Boston, but I am not sure of my desire there — most taught after internship in country but suits less my long range plans.

Many letters from Holland. The uncle Dr. Bos, is reported to be arriving in New York — tonight. I will attend him tomorrow. Rest of week will not be gay. I think (via cable from Paris) he hopes to get to Colorado — though he may not have enough money. Currency export restrictions from Holland make rich men relatively paupers when travelling.
