I..So much of "General Orders," No. 195,-of November 24, 1862, as dismisses Lieutenant Colonel F. C. Crutchmar, (*Kretschmar*,) 103d New York Volunteers, is hereby revoked.

II..The "General Orders," No. 11, from Headquarters Thirteenth Army Corps, dated November 26, 1862, dismissing 2d Lieutenant *Addison L. Page*, 30th Illinois Volunteers, with forfeiture of all pay and allowances due him, is, by direction of the President, hereby confirmed, the said Page having been found guilty, by a General Court Martial, of "forgery, bribery and corruption, and conduct unbecoming an officer and a gentleman."
