Issue of Flour to Hospitals.

The following order of August 19, 1864, is published for the information and guidance of all concerned:

The Quartermaster's Department, when fitting up or erecting hospitals, will construct the ovens. Expenses incurred in repairs to hospital bakeries will be paid from the hospital fund. The Subsistence Department will issue flour to hospitals upon the usual requisitions from Surgeons in charge.
