### CULTIVATED FOOD PLANTS.

MANKIND as an agency in the modification of species through the conscious or unconscious selection coincident with the necessity for vegetable food, and the occupation of the same areas, has, as yet, received little attention from investigators. And yet, when we note the extent of the variation produced by man in domesticated species of plants, we cannot but suspect that his influence has been exerted to a greater or less extent from the beginnings of his history. In the narratives of explorers and early discoverers we find evidence that the aborigines of nearly every country have cultivated or protected certain food plants, even those peoples classed as but slightly civilized, as for example, the indigenes of Australia. It is difficult to conceive of man as existing without influencing the vegetable productions of his region, whether directly through forethought, or indirectly through changing the physical aspect of the habitat, or through the destruction of individual plants gathered for use or destroyed through other means.

The influence of man in the distribution of plant species has received a greater or less attention from botanists, as is evidenced by the notes in local floras, lists of ballast plants, etc., in our periodicals, and in the more formal works on the geographical distribution of plants; the influence of man in the destruction of plants is recognized partially, as evidenced by the complaints of the disappearance of certain plants from limited habitats through the eagerness of plant collectors, and in more formal works on forestry and kindred subjects; the influence of man in modifying certain plants finds recognition in the writings of Darwin and his followers; and yet what has already been accomplished but portrays the stronger the poverty of our information. We seem to know more concerning the effect from insect modification, and yet we must believe that correlative disturbance is as marked in one case as in the other, although perhaps in a different direction.

The study of variation as dependent upon man's agency is a fascinating one, but before it can be successfully carried out, much preliminary work is to be done. We must separate our botanical species into three lists, at the least: the one including the strictly wild plants; another the escapes from cultivation; the third, those plants which are or have been cultivated or domesticated. Observation should then be made upon the limits of variation, with the probable causes, in the plants of these lists. This study will undoubtedly lead us to separate the observed variations into two classes: first, those beneficial to the plant; second, those which are not or have not been useful to the plant. These latter variations

we may assume provisionally are the effect of man's interference, while the former are true co-relationships with the plant's needs.

If this proposition is correctly founded, it will follow that all variations of a nature beneficial to man and not especially beneficial to the purposes of the feral plant, found existing in a so-called wild plant, will point unmistakably to a modifying influence, at some period of the plant's history, through the influence of man.

As a contribution to the preparatory material for such a study as is here outlined, I present a list of the esculent plants which are recorded as cultivated, or are known to me to be cultivated. I do this the more willingly, as, to the best of my information, no such list is to be found upon record. In some cases I have preferred not to unite synonyms, as the specific name applies to a form sufficiently well established for economic purposes, although not considered as genetically distinct. This list can, however, by no means be regarded as complete.
