HE Afylum was opened on the 23d of Sept. 1793. The nature and defign of this inftitution having been formerly laid before the public, it is unneceffary to enlarge upon it, on the prefent occasion. Suffice it to fay, that the great object of the charity is to administer relief and comfort to those poor unfortunate people, who, by the hand of God, have been deprived of the common means of earning their bread, and reduced to the most depressed, helples fituation. It will give particular pleasure to the friends of the institution to be informed, that they have been the inftruments of alleviating the affliction of a number of their fellow creatures, and of providing for their fupport, by enabling them to work for their own fubfiftence. The blind in the Afylum are no longer a burden to themfelves and to the public, but are ufeful members of fociety, and enjoy life with fome degree of comfort. 20 are upon the Society's funds, and all of them appear to be contented, chearful, and happy. Some receive 3s, others 4s, and three 5s, a week. The manufactures in which they are employed.

employed, are, making bafkets and hampers of all kinds, matts of tarred and white rope, for cleaning the fhoes at our doors, fail cloth do. mattreffes both of hair and wool, and in picking oakum. The Directors have it under deliberation, to teach them to weave fail cloth, and any other manufacture which the blind are capable of learning. The houfe where they carried on their work, in Shakefpeare Square, being too fmall, the Directors have purchased one in the Caftle-hill, in a more healthy fituation, where the blind are much better accommodated, and where a greater number can be received, if the public fhall continue to favour the inftitution. The house coft L. 375 .- From the difadvantages under which the blind labour, they must be flow in their operations, and cannot be fuppofed to earn near fo much as is allowed them. The great object is to have them creditably and ufefully employed. On Saturday afternoon, they are inftructed in the principles of religion, and every morning and evening, family worship is performed.

Regular accounts of the receipt and expenditure, after having been examined by the Auditors, are laid before a General Meeting of the Society, every quarter, and have been approved of. The quarterly meetings of the Society are held in the Afylum, on the third Tuefday of Feb. third Tuefday of May, third Tuefday of Aug. and third Tuefday of Nov. at 2 o'clock, afternoon. The Directors have an ample reward for their trouble, in the pleafing reflection, that the public feem to approve their conduct, and encourage them to go on in their labour of love. It would gratify them much, to be able to admit all who apply, and to extend their plan likewife to women, which in their prefent fituation, it is with regret, they cannot do. Contributions will be received by the Treasurer and Secretary, or by any of the Directors. An annual fubfcription will be neceffary to give the Society a permanent establishment. A number of Gentlemen have already put down their names, as appears by the annexed lift. In Liverpool, L. 400 are fubfcribed annually.
