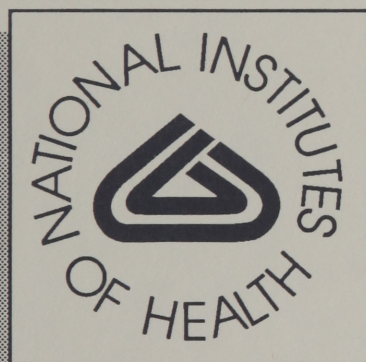
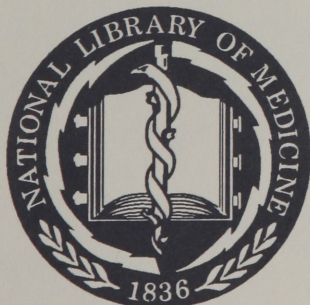

## HISTORY OF NEUROSURGERY

The National Library of Medicine's HISTLINE (History of Medicine Online) database was the source of material for this bibliography. It includes references to journal articles, monographs, dissertations, and conference papers, as well as historical chapters in general monographs, which were primarily published between 1970 and 1988. A few citations to literature back to 1968 are also included. Please note that some of the citations from non-medical sources are not in the NLM collection. An Appendix, prepared with the collaboration of Dr. Dale C. Smith, lists a number of classic works in the history of neurosurgery which were published prior to the creation of HISTLINE.

This bibliography was issued in conjunction with an exhibit on "Classics in the History of Neurosurgery" held at the National Library of Medicine on April-July, 1989. The exhibit was prepared by the Library's History of Medicine Division in cooperation with the American Association of Neurological Surgeons. Special thanks are due to Drs. Roy Selby and Dale C. Smith for their assistance with the exhibit.

"Neurological" is the directly searchable Keyword Subtopic under the Keyword "Surgery"

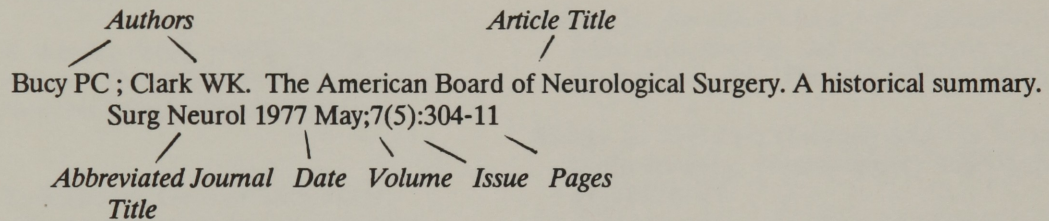
## GRATEFUL MED

This software was specifically developed for health professionals and features multiple choice menus and "fill in the blank" screens for easy search preparation. GRATEFUL MED runs on an IBM PC (or IBM-compatible) with DOS 2.0 and a Hayes (or Hayes-compatible) modem. It may be purchased from the National Technical Information Service in Springfield, Virginia, for \$29.95 (plus \$3.00 per order for shipping). 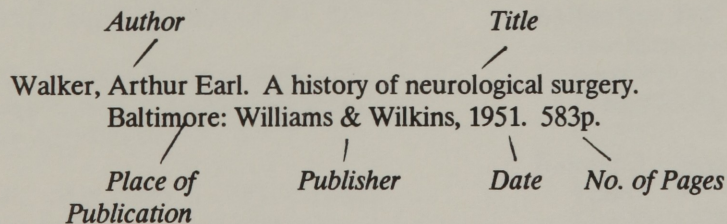
## SAMPLE CITATIONS

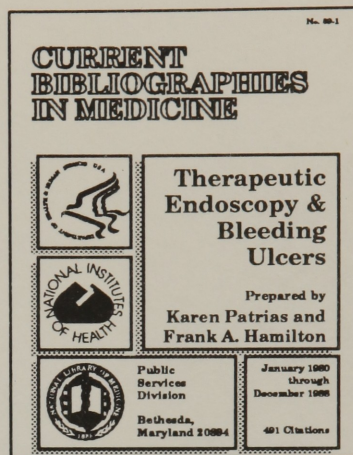
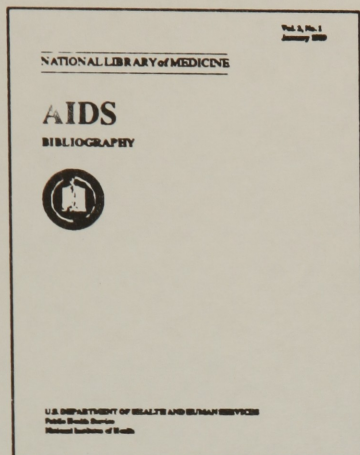

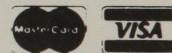
